DIRECTORS CORNER:

Why can't I feed the wild animals? The Association has a very good reason to prohibit feeding of the wildlife that are found here at Skye Loch. Wildlife are very capable of feeding themselves and have been doing it for centuries.

Rule Article VI section 6.7 states;

No feeding of animals, birds, fish or turtles is allowed at any time.

Animals, mainly squirrels, cause damage to yours and your neighbors property when they are encouraged to be in the area due to humans feeding them. The food left behind also encourages rats to find a home in yours or your neighbors roof, soffit and AC ducts. Recently a villa owner incurred repair costs of \$2,000 because a neighbor was feeding the squirrels.

No matter how well intended, feeding wild animals is prohibited! It will be seen as any other violation of our Rules and Regulations and enforced as the rules allow!

This new game is every Tuesday, beginning at 6:30 in the Community Building kitchen. 10 rounds will be played and last about an hour. Of course you can play any number of rounds you choose. The payouts range from \$35 to \$40 to the winner. Each person playing will have a strip of three laminated cards from a deck of playing cards. Each strip is different. The Game Caller will call out one card at a time. When you have a match, you will put a marker on that card. When you've covered ALL THREE, you call out, "Show Me the Money' and raise your hand. Once a winner is declared, that round is closed. In the occasional event there are two winners, the money is split. Each round is \$1.00 per laminated card. Bringing \$1.00 bills is helpful regarding making change. At the start of the evening, the cards will be on a table. You can select your own card(s). Depending on turn out, you could select up to three cards. Come join the playing fun!
