DIRECTORS CORNER:

Reminder - If you will be leaving Skye Loch for the summer season, please secure all of your outdoor furniture/decorative items or anything that could be blown away, such as vehicle covers, etc. With potential strong storms, these items can become projectiles which may cause damage to your property and/or your neighbors. Taking precautions now will be the safest steps to take.

Also, if you will be traveling during the rainy season, even for a short trip, you will want to secure your property. Hurricanes and tropical storms can form and intensify rapidly in as little as 7 to 10 days. Be prepared!

Yard Debris – Leaves and small branches, twigs or cuttings should be bagged and placed inside the dumpsters. The Association does not have someone to pick up these items for you. The lawn mowing crew will either mow over or around the debris. It is not part of their contract with our Association to pick this debris up.

Parking on the street is prohibited with the exception of commercial/contractor vehicles or vehicles servicing a residence. Residents may park for no more than 1 hour at a time to load and unload vehicles.
