DIRECTORS CORNER:

Yes, Spring will be upon us before we know it. Time to start our Spring Cleaning List:

Driveway and carport pad – Does your driveway need cleaning? How about your carport flooring – cleaning or a new coat of paint for faded or chipped/peeling paint?

Plants – trim overgrown plants, remove dead ones and you might even have to thin them out. Check to make sure your plants are not blocking your villa address numbers. This is important for deliveries but also for emergency services.

Yard Debris – Leaves and small branches, twigs or cuttings should be bagged and placed inside the dumpster. The Association does not have someone to pick up these items for you.

Another way to spruce up your villa is to paint your metal mansard cap if it is rusty.

Exterior Change Requests - As a reminder, no structural additions, alterations or improvements may be made to the exterior of any unit and/or yard without submitting an Exterior Change Request form. The form must be submitted to the Board for review and approval before any work begins.

Also, as a reminder, furniture and large items are not to be placed in the dumpster. If you need large items hauled away, the City of Dunedin will pick up items of this nature. You just need to call our property manager, Keith Phillips at 727-480-2249 and indicate you have a large appliance or furniture to be taken away. He can give you more specifics as to the day of the week it would be picked up.
